Key:

Retention: The number of students from the original spring 2014-15 cohort that have graduated, temporarily stopped-out, or are currently enrolled divided by the number of students in the original cohort.

Placement: The number of students from the original spring 2014-15 cohort who are employed in the medical assisting or related field.

Grad Part, Grad Sat: The percentage of cohort graduates participating in a post-graduate survey, and the percentage reporting they are satisfied with the program per MAERB calculation methodology.

Emp Part, Emp Sat: The percentage of employers participating in a survey requesting feedback on the program's graduates, and the percentage reporting they are satisfied with the student's work per MAERB calculation methodology.

Exam Part, Exam Pass: The percentage of all program graduates, without regard to entrance cohort, taking at least one of the industry-related exams, and the percentage who successfully passed per MAERB calculation methodology.
