SUBJECT: Articulation Agreement - Addendum

Indiana University of Pennsylvania and Penn Highlands Community College entered into an Articulation Agreement in January 2020 to facilitate the transfer of graduates from associate's degrees in disciplines at PHCC to subsequent bachelor's degrees at IUP.

Upon review of additional academic curricula, the parties desire to amend the agreement to include an articulation for the AAS in Criminal Justice (Exhibit C, attached). All other terms and conditions of the Articulation Agreement including previous Exhibits A (Fashion Merchandising) and B (Safety Science) remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
