To be admitted to the College of Business and Economics, students must have an overall GPA of 2.25. Students must also complete the following College of Business and Economics prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C or better:

ACC 150 & ACC 230

MAT 145/MAT 205 & MAT 200

ECO 100 & ECO 110

• CIT 100

• ENG 110 & ENG 205

Students completing this proposed pathway may choose to major within one of the following College of Business and Economics fields: Accounting; Economics; Entrepreneurship and Innovation; Finance; General Business; Hospitality & Tourism; Human Resource Management; Management Information Systems; Marketing; Supply Chain Management.

Depending upon the student's choice of major, additional criteria for admissions must also be met:

- Accounting: A grade of B- or higher in ACC 150 & ACC 230. A minimum grade of C- in MAT 145.
- Economics: One B- or higher, and one C- or higher in ECO 100 and ECO 110; a grade of C- or higher in MAT 205.
- Finance: A grade of B- or higher in ECO 100 & ECO 110; a grade of C- in MAT 205.
- General Business: minimum grade of C- in MAT 145.
- Hospitality & Tourism: minimum grade of C- in MAT 145.
- Human Resource Management: minimum grade of C- in MAT 145.
- Entrepreneurship and Innovation: minimum grade of C- in MAT 145.
- Management Information Systems: A grade of C- or higher in MAT 205.
- Marketing: minimum grade of C- in MAT 145.
- Supply Chain Management: C- or higher in MAT 205.

^{**}Students need to complete only MAT 145 (MATH 126) for some majors in the Chambers College of Business and Economics. Students will need to complete MAT 205 (MATH 150) with a C- or higher only if pursuing one of these majors: Economics, Finance, Supply Chain Management, and Management Information Systems.

^{***}Although not directly equivalent to WVU's ACCT 201 and ACCT 202, ACC 150 and ACC 230 will be utilized to fulfill the Financial and Managerial Accounting requirements.
